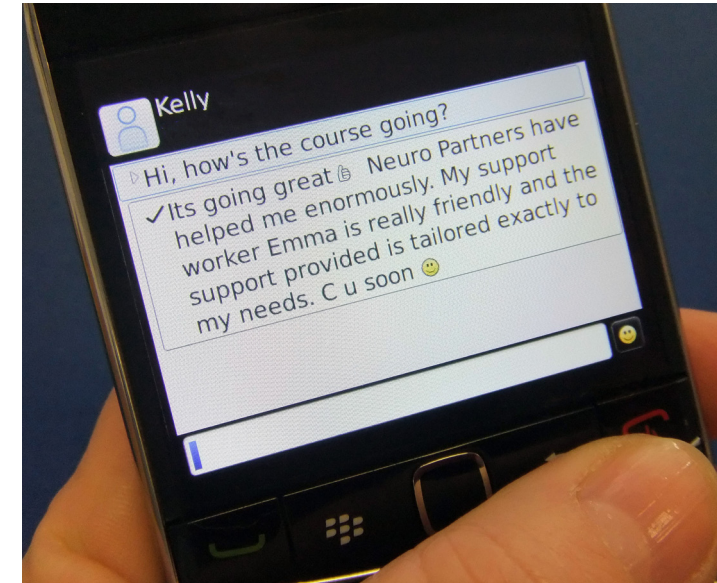

How We Work

We use a Person Centred Approach and all of our packages are designed to meet the requirements of the individual Service User whether at home, in the community, educational setting or workplace.

Working directly with students, or in partnership with Disability Support Services, we deliver a range of support packages, all tailored to the individual needs of the student.



We treat each individual on a case by case basis, no two are the same. We deliver support in accordance with what the student has been funded for, in a manner that works for the student, ensuring the outcome meets with their requirements.

Our Educational Support staff undergo rigorous training which is continuously reviewed, and they are managed by a team of experienced professionals such as Occupational Therapists, Psychologists, etc.

All of the students we work with have regular reviews to ensure that the service continues to meet their needs and objectives. We constantly encourage their views and listen to their feedback and requirements.

For most students, funding is available from the Student Loans Company located in educational establishments. Neuro Partners can signpost you to the relevant parties, if required.
